APPLICATION OF DIGITAL GENERAL SKILLS AS A MODERENIZATION OF THE SCOUTING MOVEMENT

Scout movement is an extracurricular activity that is almost always present in every primary and junior high school education. Scout is an extracurricular activity that fills educational material that is not taught in formal education. The Scout Movement teaches positive values such as being independent, having a high sense of responsibility, caring for one another, and having an attitude of holding on to prevailing norms and values. Unfortunately, scouting activities are less requested by the younger generation, therefore there is a need for a modernization movement in Scout. General Skills Requirements are requirements that must be mastered so that Scout members can proceed to the next level, General Proficiency Requirements are usually recorded in printed media in the form of a booklet. Unfortunately, this booklet was compiled using low quality materials so that the booklet could be easily damaged or lost, even though this book contains important notes on exam results. The data shows that 92.3% of Scout members use smartphones as the most frequently used gadget. Due to the dominance of the use of mobile devices, this data is used as the basis for choosing a mobile platform. Based on this phenomenon, a mobile application design for digital General Proficiency Requirements was made as an effort to maintain scout members records while at the same time attracting the attention of new generations in participating in Scouting activities.
