Abstract

This study looks at the effects of implementing an agile work en-vironment on employee performance, emphasizing the importance of inven-tion and absorptive capacity. To remain competitive in today's fast-paced business environment, firms must be adaptive and agile. In order to increase productivity and stimulate creativity, an agile work environment supports cooperation and schedule flexibility. The study used a quantitative method-ology and Partial Least Squares (PLS) analysis with 200 workers from Jakar-ta, Indonesian companies. According to the results, fluid work environments greatly increase creativity and absorptive capacity, both of which boost worker performance. Though both invention and absorptive capacity are cru-cial, innovation does not always result in a noticeable boost in performance. accomplishment.
