Incinerator	:Alternative technology to solve the waste problem .
Incineration	:Incineration is a waste treatment technology that involves the combustion of organic materials and/or substances .The output is ash and flue gases.
Spatial	:A spatial type interaction identifies needs for adjacency or orientation between two elements.
Energy	:An energy type interaction identifies needs for adjacency or orientation between two elements.
Information	:An information type interaction identifies needs for adjacency or orientation between two elements
Material	:A information type interaction identifies needs for adjacency or orientation between two elements.
Required	: Necessary for functionality
Desired	: Beneficial, but not absolutely necessary for functionality.
Indifferent	: Does not affect functionality
Undesired	:Causes negative effects but does not prevent functionality.
Detrimental	: Must be prevented to achieve functionality
Clustering	:Clustering is the task of grouping a set of objects in such a way that objects in the same group (called cluster)
Chunks	: Physical building blocks
Decomposition	: Broken down into simpler elements
