

## ABSTRACT

This study aimed to empirically test the effect of the influence of organizational commitment, the internal control system of government and good corporate governance on the performance of government agencies in Bekasi City Department of Education. This study uses primary data from the original data from the original

source using questionnaires, the sample used is 80 respondents. Data analysis methods used for testing the hypothesis is multiple regression analysis with SPSS version 20.00.

The results showed that partially significant influence organizational commitment  $t_{count} > t_{table} = 2.742 > 1.9917$  against the performance of government agencies, government internal control significant influence  $2,152 > 1.9917$  against pemrintah agency performance, and good corporate governance significant effect on the performance of government agencies  $6.006 > 1.9917$ . R-square value is equal to 0,806, which means that 64.9% of the independent variables in the study were able affect the dependent variable. While the remaining 35.1% is explained by other variables not included in this study.
