dramaturgy aspect in the phenomenon of cosplay activities in Bandung Cosplay

Communities.

This research utilized a phenomenological which was based upon constructivism

paradigm. It is strongly related to dramaturgy regarding to front stage and backstage. So the

researcher can understand any matters and in what circumtances that made a cosplayer has

their current self identity.

The data retrival was technically conducted through a series of extensive interviews

and observations. The result reveals that the cosplayers in Bandung Cosplay Communities

have an almost identical view of each other regarding to cosplay activities, however there are

differences in self identity when doing cosplay activity. They do lots of effort like costume

making, trying to be in character also making a story plot to perform. When they are on stage

cosplayer throw out their true self identity and try to be someone else. A cosplayer also try to

make an ilusion as if they bring a fictional world into reality even for only temporary.
