

## **ABSTRACT**

*The main function of Islamic education in elementary schools is that students are equipped with basic skills related to critical thinking skills, reading, writing, calculating, science, and communication skills with learning methods based on al-quran and as sunnah. The private elementary school of assalaam Bandung is an institution run by the Assalaam foundation with a basic education level which is taken 6 years from grade 1 to grade 6 starting from the age of 7 years. Curriculum used refers to the National Curriculum 2013. Assalaam elementary school is one of the Islamic schools located on Jl. Sasak Gantung No.1-4, this school is the fifth best school in Bandung since 2000 until now.*

*Assalaam School Bandung is classified as a private school that implements a full day system in its teaching hours. Currently interior planning has not been a top priority in this school building, but with the interior arrangement can improve the convenience of learning activities. Plus the lack of implementation of the design on the vision of the Assalaam elementary school. This is evidenced by the lack of facilities and infrastructure to support the formal learning process of students is the application of ergonomics of furniture which refers to Permendiknas Number 24 of 2007 about the standard facilities and infrastructure for SD / MI.*
