ABSTRACT

The formation of KNKG to provide guidance for companies to do Good Corporate Governance (GCG) and also there is a regulation for each company to be a pioneer to do GCG principles to avoid the economic crisis and help the country's economy. Companies listed on the Indonesia Stock Exchange (BEI) are expected to perform the best GCG. One of them is PT. Sarana Menara Nusantara that already exist in BEI. To measure whether or not the company is doing GCG then the assessment should be done, one of them through self-assessment.

This study aims to determine how good or not implementation of PT. Sarana Menara Nusantara in doing GCG principles and to know what suggestion or recommendation of next step to keep up with GCG principles.

Data collection methods in this study is through direct interviews of the parties concerned in the internal company to answer the question of self-assessment questionnaire. This research also uses descriptive analysis to know the general description of the data obtained.

The results of this study indicate that PT. Sarana Menara Nusantara has done Good Corporate Governance very well as seen from the self-assessment result of 98.3% from 100%.

The shortcomings can be seen from these results where there is one problem that arises that is the absence of policies on public investors that can be easily accessed by the regulator and the general public, because the company does not have the policy and the company only follow the policies and rules issued by OJK and BEI.
