Culture is a way of life that develops, and is owned by a group of people and passed down from generation to generation. *Mepasah* tradition is carried out down and down from the blood of the descendants of Bali Aga in Trunyan Village, Kintamani, Bangli, Bali. People who die are not buried or burned, but are left to rot at the ground. This unique tradition in the Trunyan Village has been carried out by the local community until now. Therefore, the authors are interested in bringing this phenomenon into a documentary with a duration of 10 minutes. This documentary film work aims to introduce traditional culture from the background of the overall phenomenon, and how to preserve culture in documentary films.
