ABSTRACT

The purpose of this research is to understand the semiotic meaning behind da'wah communication about patience on the level of reality, representation and ideology. To achieve the purposes, researcher use qualitative research method with John Fiske's semiotic approach. Based on "The Codes of Television" which is divided into three levels, such as reality level, representation level, and ideology level. The result shows that da'wah communication about patience was shown by showing a man with the activities that he is doing. On reality level, da'wah communication about patience was shown through the code of costume, movement, expression, setting, and text. While on representation level, the depiction of da'wah communication was shown through the code of camera, sound, and music. Lastly, on the level of ideology, da'wah communication about patient was represented in patience virtue.
