The research method used is Qualitative This research method uses descriptive qualitative with a constructivism paradigm where this paradigm sees how everyone basically has thoughts and can construct these relationships which certainly involves emotions or personal life experiences. The results of this study also found that Historical and Linguistics became a dominant thing in the meaning of a song, especially in the song "Orang Utan" created by *Oppie Andaresta, this is because the experience or events that occur will* be more felt when included in a songs accompanied by a language and words that are easy to understand. Researchers see that the creators of the text want to influence their listeners by inviting them as humans must keep the Orang Utans from extinction by preserving the forest.
