ABSTRACT

The Javanese Diaspora Network Community is one of three communities that cover several small Javanese communities throughout the world. In contrast to other communities that only gather on Facebook groups to communicate, the Javanese diaspora Network community formed offline programs to interact directly with fellow members. The purpose of this study is to describe the group's communication patterns that occured in the event "The 4th Event of Gathering The Seperated Bones". In this study the communication patterns used is star communication patterns. The method used in this study is qualitative using a case deskriptive. The results of this study indicated that the communication pattern the Javanese Diaspora Network Community used is star-shaped communication pattern, this communication pattern is called the all channel communication network or all channel, the communication process used is primary and secondary processes. In terms of barriers to communication, this community is hampered because 50 percent of the members of this community only understand Javanese ngoko (rough Javanese) and lack of understanding of Javanese kromo (fine java).
