ABSTRACT

The existence of neglected children on the streets is a reflection of the lack of equal distribution of social welfare that occurs in the community, especially in the city of Bandung. Most of these children live and live in childcare institutions. The number of children's orphanages in the city of Bandung does not necessarily have the full feasibility for the foster children to live in. Amanah Children's Orphanage is one example of an orphanage-based child welfare institution that accommodates abandoned children, orphans and poor people. Hopefully, they want to create comfort for foster children even though they come from different backgrounds, ages but they can still feel together in a pleasant home so that they can be easier to socialize.
