advantages that are willing to maximise the between-class scatter matrix and

minimize the within-class scatter matrix to maintain the separation between

classes.

The results of this study is a facial expression recognition systems that are

able to detect a facial expressions and classify them into two types, they are

drowsiness and tidak mengantuk expressions using data from Yawning Detection

Dataset (YawDD). This dataset have 400 datas and divided into 100 test datas and

100 train datas for dashboard also 100 test datas and 100 train datas for mirror.

The performance generated from the system are 97% accurate using the Principal

Component Analysis (PCA) method with eigenfaces parameter as feature

extraction and Linear Distance Analysis using Bayes Prior distance as the

classification.
