

MOBILE DESIGN OF SUNDA LANGUAGE START E-LEARNING APPLICATION FOR BASIC SCHOOL CHILDREN

This era and sophisticated technology has become a daily necessity for humans, especially in the acceleration of information that allows us to get or know new information quickly and efficiently through technology. Especially in the world of education where technology has become a tool / medium for learning. Indonesia is a nation rich in regional languages. The number collected by the Summer Institute of Linguistics (SIL) in 2006 reached 741 languages. One of them is Sundanese, according to Rouffaer (1905: 16), the Sundanese word comes from the root word *sund* or the word *suddha* in Sanskrit which has the meaning of shining, bright, shiny, white. Regional Languages in West Java which include Sundanese, Cirebon Language and Betawi Malay Language are agreed to serve as local content for subjects independently. This is in accordance with the West Java regional regulation No. 5 of 2003 concerning learning Language and Regional Literature at the level of primary and secondary education in West Java. In Bandung especially in SDN 006 Buah Batu is a school that has a Sundanese Language curriculum, this school teaches Sundanese Language as one of the subjects that must be available for students in SD 006 Buah Batu. In SD 006 this is based on the Education Curriculum in 2013. E-learning applications can display material more interesting with the help of picture or illustrative media, this is so that students at SDN 006 Buah Batu can be easier to remember the material taught and grow interest in learning. As well as the E-learning application can increase the enthusiasm of teachers in delivering local content material in Sundanese language.
