Based on the results of this study concluded that the response to the Purchase Decision

variable with the percentage score of the Purchase Decision variable questionnaire was 80.93%

at an interval position of 68% - 84% with a good category. Product Design variable with the

percentage score of the Product Design variable questionnaire was 56.04% at an interval

position of 52% - 68% in the unfavorable category. And the Product Quality variable with the

Product Quality variable is 81.28% at an interval position of 68% - 84% in the good category.
