Abstract

The needs of the Cipacing community for health services have recently increased (cited from an interview with the Cipacing Harapan Keluarga Hospital). A good hospital certainly prioritizes the quality and quality of service to consumers. Besides, physical and interior shape also plays a role in determining the good/bad of consumers' perceptions of the hospital. At least with the physical and interior shape of a good hospital building will be able to reduce the creepy impression that accelerates the healing process.
