

ABSTRACT

The redesign of the Balekambang Surakarta Dance Art Building is a park that was built by KGPA A Mangkunegara VII for its two daughters, which initially functioned as a water park and KGPA A Mangkunegara's private estate. In 2008 revitalization of Balekambang Park was begun and functioned as an art and cultural park. The Balekambang Surakarta Dance Hall functions as a place of preservation and performance of the Ramayana Ballet dance for the people of Surakarta and Surakarta visitors.

Redesign of the Balekambang Surakarta Dance Art Building is a redesign of an existing building located in the Balekambang area, Surakarta.
