ABSTRACT

Abortion is a fetal miscarriage caused by abortion either intentional or unintentional because one of the factors is an unwanted pregnancy. The factor of teenagers having an abortion is simply because of low family control and good communication. Therefore it is very necessary good communication between needed and children and the function of the family as a vehicle to educate, nurture and socialize children, develop the ability of all members to achieve a prosperous family. That is because the lower functioning of a family, the mischievousness will be higher and vice versa. This study aims to determine how family communication patterns in implementing family functions in abortion offenders by using the theory of Fitzpatrick and Koerner is family communication patterns. The research method used is qualitative with a phenomenological approach and constructivist paradigm. The results of this study indicate that family communication patterns in implementing family functions through conversation orientation and conformity orientation in families with perpetrators of abortion have the most dominant function applied to religious functions and protection functions, another function that is still applied is reproductive function and there are differences in patterns Family communication is based on the experience of children who have abortions in emphasizing family functions, especially on religious functions and protection functions.
