ABSTRACT

The area of West Sumatra which is famous for brass metal craftsmen is Nagari Sungai Pua which is located in the Agam Regency, West Sumatra Province. Crafts produced from brass metal is a Talempong musical instrument. Talempong handicraft production activities itself is a hereditary effort. This can be seen from the expertise of the Nagari Sungai Pua community to produce Talempong musical instruments. This brass craft was in the top position to be excellent in 1977 - 1985. At this time, Talempong craftsmen in Nagari Sungai Pua experienced decline. This final work is in the form of a documentary film with the theme of the condition of the Talempong brass craftsman in Nagari Sungai Pua, which is the only Talempong area of craftsmen in West Sumatra, whose number of craftsmen has declined. This final work refers to the nickname of Nagari Sungai Pua which is "Nagari Pandai Basi and Kuningan". The documentary with the title "Denyut Nadi Talempong" with a duration of 14 minutes is aimed at enabling people to get to know more about Talempong Crafts and to preserve this hereditary culture.
