

ABSTRACT

Broken home is a condition in which a family experiences divisions or gaps in the household. The phenomenon of broken home in Indonesia has increased every year and causes opportunities for children to make deviations. Therefore, the Hamur Inspiring community since 2015 until now was born as a forum for broken home children spread throughout Indonesia. By having the goal to create a broken home survivor who is inspiring for his environment, there are no restrictions that prevent them from developing their potential. The purpose of this research is to find out how the communication patterns in the Hamur Inspiring Indonesia community. The researcher uses the social constructivist paradigm with a qualitative descriptive study approach that aims to find out deeply and interpret the meanings held by members of the Hamur Inspiring community about their world. Data is collected through in-depth interviews with semi-structured questions, and utilizing relevant literature studies. The results obtained that the communication patterns or networks created in the Hamur Inspiring community are star communication patterns and wheel communication patterns. As well as the impacts arising from the communication patterns carried out are cognitive and affective impacts, so that the Hamur community can be regarded as a community with a type of growth group.
