ABSTRACT

INTERIOR RE-DESIGN OF WIDHYA ASIH ORPHANAGE IN BALI

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The orphanage is a home for orphans where they lived and cared. With the large number of orphanages in Indonesia, it does not guarantee that the orphanage is suitable for foster children to live in. Widhya Asih's orphanage is one example of orphanage institutions that are scattered throughout the island of Bali.
