ABSTRACT

Communication Effective learning is needed in teaching and learning activities. In learning activities can not be separated from the communication process carried out between educators and students. In the learning communication process there are components that influence one another, namely educators, messages, channels, students, feedback and barriers to learning communication. Barriers to learning communication can take the form of language use, educator imagery, learning environment and misunderstanding in delivering messages or learning material.
