

ABSTRACT

Badung is a city that has quite a lot of Green Open Space (RTH), which covers an area of 1700 hectares. Gasibu Park is one of the green open spaces designed by the Bandung city government to facilitate the community, with park facilities provided such as jogging tracks, libraries and natural stone reflections. With all the facilities provided, it is an attraction for people to visit Gasibu Park. However, Gasibu Park does not provide children play area facilities, it makes children who play in the park area not at facilities intended for play, which makes other community activities can be disrupted. As one case of children who play in the jogging track where the jogging track is not intended for children's play. Play for children is a natural thing in the period of growth into adulthood, children will get joy when playing, children's play needs must also be considered as well as the needs of adults, according to Law No. 23 of 2002 concerning children's rights (Article 11). Gasibu Park as a green open space or thematic park with a theme park designed by the government does not provide facilities or facilities for children's playgrounds where a good children's playground is a green open space. Ideally sports parks like Gasibu Park should have facilities for playing children such as playgrounds. Moreover, Gasibu Park has a large land area of 26,000 M2. researchers conducted interviews and environmental observations to find out the habits or activities of the people visiting Gasibu Park and to find out the importance of children's play facilities. By conducting interviews and observations researchers found phenomena or problems that occur in the field such as library facilities, jogging tracks, and natural stone reflections, but there is no means for children to play in Gasibu Park as green space.
