ABSTRACT

Higher education has an important role to contribute in achieving the Sustainable Development Goals 2030 (SDGs 2030) as the institution to educate human resources who have quality education. This study aims to identify students' point of view on the Sustainable Development Goals Center (SDGs Center) designated by BAPPENAS (National Development Planning Agency) at the Bandung Institute of Technology (ITB). Through a mixed method approach, this research identifies the perspectives of ITB Student representatives, namely the Student Body President and the Head of the Ministry of Creative Communication and Information of KM ITB (ITB Student Family), also through a questionnaire filled out by ITB Students.

The Bandung Institute of Technology has six SDGs 2030 goals that are the focus of the SDGs Center. This research focuses on SDG 4 "Quality Education" which is in line with the focus of BAPPENAS as outlined in the 2019 Voluntary National Reviews, and the position of the ITB as a formal educational institution. This research contributes to provide an overview and input for other SDGs Centers, as well as universities that do not yet have SDGs Centers, and in order to guard SDGs Centers to contribute in achieving SDGs 2030.

Students stated that Quality Education is very important at ITB. It can be seen from how the Student and ITB organizations that have programs prepared for this. However, the programs or main tasks and functions of the SDGs Center ITB are deemed invisible. The views of the students identified that the SDGs Center ITB still does not have a existency for ITB students, and it is hoped that the SDGs Center ITB will involve more students to contribute to achieving SDGs 2030 together.
