Kosicki who perceive news framing from syntactic, script, thematic, and rhetorical structures. In this researcher is using constructivist paradigm and qualitative research method. The result showed that detik.com accentuates KPU as positive sides to including people with mental disabilities voter and shows negative interpretation from a viewpoint of politician and important figure who shares negative responds towards people with mental disabilities vote, and also the use of terms about people with mental disabilities. The conclusion of this research is detik.com shows alignments towards authority and also emphasize interpretation and negative viewpoint towards people with mental disabilities voter.
