**ABSTRACT**

film is very well received and has even received awards from several film festivals.

This study used a qualitative research method with a film criticism approach

with cinematographic elements from the aesthetic formalism theory of Sergei

Eisenstein and film theory and cinematographic techniques in general. From this

theory, the writer analyzes several scenes in the film that have traumatic traits so

that the writer can find out what cinematographic techniques are used in building,

shaping, and supporting the traumatic impression.

From the results of the analysis, there are several cinematographic

techniques that are often used in developing the effects of trauma on the main

characters in the film, among them are Medium Close Up, Medium Shot, Rule of

Thirds, Pan Shot, and also Head Room.
