## ABSTRACT

In an effort to monitor target 8.9 revealed in the Sustainable Development Goals in 2030, which consisted of formulating and implementing policies to support tourism resulting in new employments, while supporting local culture and products. This research was conducted at Taman Sari Resort Pemuteran, the particular resort was a perfect example of implementation of sustainable tourism and the importance of implementation carried out in accordance with point 8.9 by the 2030 Sustainable Development Goals.

The hotel is a private unit accuring beneath the UNWTO (United Nation World Tourism Organization) policy, as a policy maker in the sustainable tourism ongoing process. However along with the development of the era, hotels tend to not escape from various problems of mismanagement. Environment management is one of the solution to tackle negative impact of Solid Waste. Judjing from a variety of earlier studies, the authors decided to take three variables, namely Green Food Purchase, Green Kitchen and Plastic Prevention. These variables can be used as a measuring tool for Environmental Management.

The research uses qualitative methods along with interviews as a data collection procedure. The interviewee involved in this study were part of the Taman Sari Resort, consisting of 6 representative management and the owner. In addition the Taman Sari Resort external party consisted of 2 professional workers, 1 community leader and 1 representing government. Lastly the sample from the Taman Sari Resort guest consisted of 5 people. The other data collection procedure was based out of secondary data.

This research stated that Taman Sari Resort has committed to be responsible for purchasing local organic raw materials from around the Pemuteran community. Producing live kitchens that allow consumers to see the process, displaying the chef & the team who were specialised in preparing the food, and utilizing natural component as a replacement for plastic. Moreover there are still some rooms for improvement, for instance: purchasing eco labels raw materials, conventional menus and the end products of recycle process, which contain commercial value.

The results of the research are expected to become a benchmark for evaluating Taman Sari Resort in environmental management. Taking into account certain raw materials used, procuring the new adaptive kitchen concept and aware of the surounding environment, whilst reducing the use of plastic for operational activity. Thus Taman Sari Resort future will always be recognized an important stakeholder, priotizing on going sustainable tourism in pemuteran village.
