In this study the data were obtained by in-depth interviews, literature study and field observations. The results obtained are then analyzed, explained, and concluded. Then the conclusion is of this research is the communicative situations that occurred in the tradition, is sacred, joy, a thick magical aura, and intimacy. The communicative events that occurred started with praying together, Dharma Santi, the main event, and the ritual procession. Communicative action describes the entire verbal and non-verbal communication as well as the existing symbols. The three elements of the research results are the keys in describing to discuss how communication activities and ritual communication processes that occur in the Omed-Omedan Tradition in Banjar Kaja Sesetan, Denpasar City.*
