Evidenced by the many traditional and contemporary shows from regional to international scale held regularly every year. This phenomenon raises the need for facilities for artists to fulfill their activities, while the existing performing arts buildings have not been properly facilitated, causing a decrease in public interest to watch the performances at the facilities provided. The strategic location of the design is in Sriwedari Park which is a cultural heritage area and Slamet Riyadi road which is a protocol road, so that the land is surrounded by supporting facilities. This design was designed with the Solo cultural arts theme applied in the design where each room applies a design whose basic ideas are taken from: batik, puppets and gamelan. The atmosphere in the room is expected to reflect the cultural value of Surakarta with a blend of traditional Javanese and contemporary. This design is expected to be able to provide solutions to existing problems and attract visitors.
