Bugis and Makassar jewelery have the same style or design as the Minagkabau tribe have, this is because they brought Islam to Sulawesi. This writing is an effort to design jewelry with a method of exploring design and motifs of the Bugis tribe which aims to design jewelry sets (necklace, bracelet & earring) with contemporary types of jewelry to introduce and touch consumer interest in contemporary jewelry as a medium for introducing Bugis culture / ethnicity that has a high cultural value and artistic design.
