ABSTRACT

In this research, a design using the Zachman Framework has a 6 x 6 matrix in which there are six perspectives, namely Planner, Owner, Designer, Builder, Sub-Contractor, and User. And has six columns consisting of what, how, where, who, when, and why. This research will produce an Enterprise Architecture design in the form of Blueprint, IT Roadmap, Organizational Design, and IT Value. This final result can conclude that all the designs made are related to the object of the Office of Religious Affairs (KUA) in the marriage registration service
