

ABSTRACT

Utilization of ulin wood powder as a natural dye of sasirangan fabric for fashion products

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Ulin tree is one of Indonesia's original biological rich species that grows on the island of Borneo. Ironwood tree is widely used as raw material for construction products which causes sawdust waste, ironwood sawdust which has not been widely used, while ironwood powder can be used as a textile dye. Ironwood contains tannins that can be obtained with a hot extract system that can produce a brown color. Based on this, ironwood powder is used as a natural textile dye. Seeing its connection with Kalimantan, the author was inspired to use ironwood natural dyes in Sasirangan fabrics used as fashion products. This is following the culture suggested by the Indonesian government to make creative industries based on the Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia 11 of 2020 concerning Official Clothing, which requires ASN and Regional Governments to use PDH clothes including regional specialties. The method used is a qualitative method with data collection techniques using literature studies, interviews, observations and experiments. The final result of this research is ready-to-wear fashion products, which can be used in office activities that require the use of appropriate Indonesian cultural clothing by applying the results of processing ironwood powder into natural dyes for Sasirangan fabrics.
