The Cultural Center Foundation Building (YPK) is a historical building in the city of Bandung, West Java, Indonesia. The YPK building is located on Jl. Naripan No. 7 Bandung and now this building serves as a venue for performing arts and cultural performances. This building can also be used for seminars, congresses, meetings, even for weddings or school farewells. This building was built during the Dutch East Indies colonial rule. This building used to function as a Sositet (Meeting Hall) called Ons Genoegen. And previously in this building there was a place to play billiards, chess, playing cards, and there was also a dining and drinking room while listening to musical entertainment from bands or orchestra at that time. During the independence movement era in the 1930s, national political figures had also used it for vergadering (meetings) or political lectures.

The redesign of the Cultural Center Foundation Building aims to give the interior impression of the building that is more comfortable and relevant than before, due to several shortcomings in terms of comfort such as lack of air circulation, problems in the acoustic section, flow of activity and space organization. In addition, this redesign design has design limitations because the building is a class A cultural heritage building.
