Demi-couture is classified as special needs clothing that is made with high-level techniques of complexity and using high-quality materials. In the production process of clothes, it is known that there is textile waste that is left after the production. So, the zero waste fashion design method is applied to the clothes production process to minimize the production waste. One of the techniques that can be used was the Sashiko technique.
