ABSTRAK

Zyon is one of the startups in the mental health field that was born because of concerns

about mental health that were not handled properly. In fact, mental health is an

important aspect of human life. Therefore, the Zyon application design is based on

existing problems and provides solutions according to user needs. This research

focuses on mental health issues, namely bringing together users and psychologists on

one platform.

The results of this study are in the form of a mental health application prototype

design using the design thinking method. Design thinking IDEO by Tim Brown and

Jocelyn Wyatt which defines that there are three stages in design thinking, namely

empathy map, idea, and confirmation. At the empathy map stage, in-depth interviews

and observations are carried out to articulate the needs of users. At the idea stage,

discussions with the team are carried out to generate ideas and solutions. At the

confirmation stage, expert interviews were conducted to ensure that the proposed idea

was needed. After going through these three stages, a concept formulation was made

for the Zyon startup application design.

The resulting design results in the form of an application mockup. The Zyon

application provides consultation and various other features to make it easier for users

and psychologists to interact. The mockup of the application will be validated through

respondents and psychologists to produce a representation of the design results.

Mockup as a visualization of the design concept that has been made as a real picture

of the product design. Making a mockup as a product design is useful as an illustration

of the Zyon application. Zyon mockups provide real-world visualizations that display

an idea in its original form. The use of mockups makes it easy for repairs before

launching the application, saving time and minimizing Zyon's startup costs.
