The combination of Jambi embroidery techniques and Rajapolah weaving is a form of product innovation so that the products produced are diverse and follow developing trends. The research method uses descriptive methods with primary data collection through interviews, observations, explorations and secondary data in the form of literature studies to produce new woven designs according to current trends..
