There is a uniqueness in Bayu Satrio's work, in his work almost largely using the levitation technique, a technique that makes objects seem to float and always wants to display the ingredients contained in the food. Being a hallmark of levitation techniques does not make it get such a broad meaning, in practice non-levitation food is more to discuss regarding the visual meaning of Bayu Satrio's work. Even so, the visuals presented by this technique make many people curious about its manufacture, because it is rare to use the technique that looks different and becomes an attraction for people who see its works.
