

ABSTRACT

Based on Badan Pusat Statistik (BPS) 2020, the population of Pati Regency continues to increase, compared to the results of the previous census. With a period of 10 years from 2010 to 2020, the population of Pati Regency has increased by around 133.20 thousand people. Despite population growth and increasing mortality, it is a serious problem. Because in Pati itself there is no special hospital for mothers and children, there are only 8 hospitals including 1 RSUD (Regional General Hospital), 1 Lung Hospital and the rest as private public hospitals. Due to the increasing birth and death rates, special facilities are needed to support the safety and health of mothers and children. The high demand for maternity and children's hospitals also affects facilities and services in terms of interior design, such as an uncomfortable room atmosphere that can affect the psychology of mothers and children. Therefore this design was then carried out. This design will apply a spatial psychology approach which is expected to provide a sense of calm, comfort and pleasure while in the hospital, by applying it to aspects of interior elements such as color, shape of space or furniture.
