ABSTRACT

Sexual violence against adolescents is one of the global health problems experienced by children in the world. Referring to the high level of sexual violence that has continued to occur since 2021 in West Java, especially in the Sukabumi Regency area, is classified as an area with the highest rate of sexual violence. It takesthe role of parental communication as the first guide in the life of adolescents to prevent acts of sexual violence. Sexual violence can occur due to poor communication of acts of sexual violence, shame and fear of disclosing the incident to family, friends and service providers. The purpose of this study was to find out how the role of mother's communication in educating the prevention of sexual violence in female adolescents. This study uses the constructivism paradigm in view of the complexity of the real world, supported by qualitative methods with data collection techniques carried out by conducting interviews, observation and documentation as well as triangulation of sources to measure the credibility of the data. . The results of this study indicate that the role of communication between mothers and young women related to sexuality conversations is quite high because the interaction time is not limited so that freedom arises in giving opinions. The communication process of mothers who apply an attitude of equality creates a child's independence so that with the inculcation related to sexuality and values, rules and decisions, it causes the emergence of adolescent views on preventing acts of sexual violence.
