The phenomenon of the widespread use of floral and geometric motifs in modest clothing in Indonesia is an opportunity to create new variations of motifs using Escher's tessellation rotation technique. According to previous research, this technique can be done with other visual inspirations. The research method used is a qualitative method by means of literature studies to collect data from previous research, visual observation to process inspiration, and digital exploration to deepen the techniques and inspiration used. The final result of this research is to create a variety of floral motifs using Escher's tessellation rotation technique with the inspiration of orchids combined with supporting modules with consideration of the analysis of comparison brands and the selected concepts to be applied to modest women's clothing in the form of long dresses with digital printing techniques.
