ABSTRACT

Komnas Perempuan reports that in 2021, cases of sexual violence that occur in tertiary institutions, including well-known universities, will increase significantly. Responding to public concerns, the Ministry of Education and Culture issued a new regulation, namely a new regulation regarding anticipation, prevention and handling of sexual violence that occurs within tertiary institutions. Even though the PPKS Permendikbudristek is very good at protecting and providing a sense of security within the scope of tertiary institutions, at the time of its issuance, not a few parties took issue with this PPKS Regulation. This study aims to find out how Telkom University students perceive the Permendikbudristek policy No. 30 of 2021. In this study using a constructivism paradigm with a qualitative approach and using interview and documentation data collection techniques. Researchers conducted interviews with 20 key informants from Telkom University students. Based on the results of the perception research produced in accordance with the process of perception of sensation, attention, and interpretation, the informants feel happy with the presence of the Minister of Education and Culture by paying attention to the important points in the articles and the main objectives of the Minister of Education and Culture Regulation No. 30 of 2021 so that it supports the existence of the Minister of Education and Culture Regulation No. 30 of 2021. They considers this regulation as an instrument to enforce the law and provide clear guidelines in handling cases of sexual violence..
