



Digital literacy is awareness, attitude and ability of individuals to appropriately use digital tools and facilities to identify, access, manage, integrate, evaluate, analyze and synthesize digital resources, construct new knowledge, create media expressions, and communicate with others, in the context of specific life situations, in order to enable constructive social action. (Martin, 2006)

Technology literacy related to Information and ommunication Technology (ICT) that falls into the category of inter-literacy perspectives includes the ability to use ICT as an integral part of basic literacy (Markauskaite, 2006). Technology literacy is the ability to use, understand, regulate and assess an innovation that involves processes and knowledge to solve problems (Maryl ,2005).

Human Literacy is the process of becoming and being human through practices that require learning or relearning behaviors, which allow us to recognize our humanity and the humanity of others. The ability to recognize humanity as an interdependent relationship makes it impossible to negate another person's humanity without the expectation of dire consequences. (Mursalata, 2016)
