ABSTRACT

REDESIGN OF THE INTERIOR OF THE AUDITORIUM AND EXHIBITION AREA OF THE MANDALA WANGSIT MUSEUM WITH A TECHNOLOGICAL APPROACH

The Mandala Wangsit Siliwangi Museum is one of the active museums in Bandung. This museum holds various collections related to the history of the struggle of the Siliwangi Regional Military Command troops. The museum building is located at Jalan Lembong no. 38, was built in 1910 as a residence for Dutch officers and later turned into the headquarters of the Siliwangi Division in 1949-1950. This museum was founded in 1966 by Colonel Ibrahim Adjie, and got a renovation in 1980. Now this museum is already 42 years old since the last renovation, therefore this museum needs to be updated and renovated to meet modern standards and requirements, including circulation, space, and layout. The purpose of this research is to update the Mandala Wangsit Siliwangi Museum so that it is not outdated and conforms to the latest museum design standards and guidelines. In addition, this research aims to attract public interest in studying the pre- and post-independence history related to the Siliwangi Regional Military Command.
