ABSTRACT

Abstract: People's lifestyles have evolved with time, necessitating increased economic and educational requirements. Many women today work or attend school while caring for their family at home. Caregivers, such as maids or babysitters, may not always offer enough care to children. As a result, parents may pick daycare or nursery schools that provide PAUD programs to guarantee their children receive a good education and stimulation while they work. Daycare is important for children's development since it provides adequate stimulus to stimulate growth at the right age stages. Child development is most important between the ages of 0 and 6 (golden age), and childcare services can help improve the quality of child development. However, the main difficulty confronting daycares, particularly in Bandung City, is a lack of enough space to meet the various stimulation needs of each age group of children. As a result, successful and appropriate space sharing necessitates reorganization and relocation to a new, larger place. Telkom Foundation created Telkom School Daycare T-Moms for academics, graduate students, and employees at Telkom University and other locations. However, expanding the scope of the daycare should take into account the needs of the surrounding community. The new location was chosen for the sake of convenience, security, and accessibility. It is anticipated that the installation of daycare at the new location would foster an environment that fosters optimal stimulation of children's growth and development.
