

**LOMBOK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT INTERIOR REDESIGN
WITH A LOMBOK CULTURAL APPROACH**

ABSTRACT

Lombok is one of the islands in West Nusa Tenggara Province, and is one of the tourist destination cities in Indonesia. Tourism on the island of Lombok has experienced such rapid development that it has resulted in an increase in the number of flights, both domestic and international. The increasing number of air transport passengers has an impact on the optimal capacity of airport terminals in each area, so that Lombok International Airport which is under the auspices of PT. Persero I makes efforts to provide optimal service to all airport users by optimizing the large airport terminal area to increase passenger effectiveness. Apart from that, Lombok International Airport is a supporting facility for air transportation which has a role as a gateway for Lombok tourism and culture. In realizing the function and standards of the airport as a gateway, this airport has a role in introducing, presenting, and being able to become an icon for the island of Lombok. The current condition of Lombok International Airport (BIL) still has various shortcomings in terms of interior management. The interior of the airport terminal which has the potential to introduce Lombok culture is still minimal and does not have strong characteristics to present Lombok culture. In responding to existing problems and phenomena, there are several stages carried out in the process of redesigning Lombok International Airport. Starting from determining the design object, field survey, library and literature study, interviews, and holding discussions related to the design to produce the final design for the interior of Lombok International Airport. Based on the results of these stages, the concept that is considered to be able to solve interior problems is The Sense of Sade. It is hoped that the application of this concept can achieve final interior design results that are able to realize the role of Lombok's tourism and cultural gateway.
