REDESIGNING THE MAIN CLINIC OF PUPUK KUJANG CIKAMPEK WITH A HEALING ENVIRONMENT APPROACH

Clinics are facilities that provide health services and are widespread in Indonesia, with the number of units reaching 11,347 according to data from the Ministry of Health of the Republik of Indonesia. Currently, an endemic phenomenon is occurring in the Karawang area. However, there are still no facilities that support clinic activities during the endemic period, and no clinics that pay attention to interior aspects to support patient recovery. This condition highlights the need for the design of clinic facilities that prioritize the needs and psychological side of users, so the design of clinic facilities that meet user needs is important. In interior design, the atmosphere of the room can affect the psychological condition of the user, therefore the Healing Environment approach with the theme "user harmony with environment" can help balance and fulfill the needs of users with their environment, and support the patient's recovery process. In addition, this design also pays attention to aspects of safety, comfort, and emotional impact for patients during their activities.
