

ABSTRACT

Mosques in Islam not only function as places of worship, but also as centers for community empowerment. The Istiqlal Mosque as the state mosque of Indonesia has an important role in Islamic education, religious tourism, and social and da'wah activities. However, the major renovation carried out in 2019 to 2021 still leaves several problems, especially on the Ground Floor of the Istiqlal Mosque. The main problems identified are the instability of the function of the space due to repeated design changes and the absence of a shared space for interaction. This design report aims to redesign the interior of the Ground Floor of the Istiqlal Mosque. This redesign will focus on providing layout design solutions, optimizing the library according to standards and objectives, and maximizing the potential of other spaces. The approach used in this design is Place Making with the theme The Modern of Islam to create an interior environment that is in harmony with Islamic identity and supports community empowerment activities. Through this redesign, it is hoped that the supporting space of the Istiqlal Mosque can function more optimally, provide comfort to its users and support the transformation of the Istiqlal Mosque into a center for empowering Muslims in Indonesia that is modern, responsible and professional.
