ABSTRACT

The importance of health and hygiene is more considered by

parents, especially for children who are growing and developing. It is

concerning that many children and adolescents in Indonesia, both in

urban and rural areas, do not understand the importance of personal

and environmental hygiene. This can be seen from the increasing

number of cases of infectious diseases such as diarrhea, worms, and

even ARI based on an unclean lifestyle.

This study aims to raise the issue of using comics as a learning

medium in order to convey hygiene and health material to children in

elementary schools. Comics were chosen as a medium because they

can convey messages through stories and visuals that are interesting

to children with characters that are closely related to their daily

activities, such as washing hands, consuming nutritious food, and

disposing of garbage in its place. The research method used was a

combination of interview studies with the planning, production and

evaluation stages.

The results of the study showed that teaching materials in the form

of comics can increase children's learning motivation and stimulate

their creative thinking and are effective in implementing the PHBS

concept in daily behavior throughout elementary education. It is

hoped that these findings can enrich the development of similar media

in other areas.
