Development of A Combination of Layering Dyeing Techniques in Brush Strokes Batik with Tie-Dye on Textile Fabrics

Batik is a technique of resisting fabric using wax called malam. In terms of its manufacture, batik is divided into two types, traditional batik and contemporary batik. Contemporary batik is defined as batik that contains freedom in its manufacturing process. Over time, innovations have been found in new coloring techniques called layering techniques. This technique uses color composition in depth (layers) to produce complexity in color. The research method used is qualitative with a curiosity-based approach.
