ABSTRACT

The Indonesian Football Association (PSSI) is increasingly aggressively carrying out the process of naturalizing foreign players who have Indonesian descent in order to strengthen the performance of the Indonesian national team. However, the process is inseparable from various problems that arise, especially regarding allegations of dual citizenship, which has led to various debates in various parties. Referring to this, this research aims to find out how two online media, Tempo.co and Tribunnews.com, framed the news on the issue of dual citizenship in naturalized players of the Indonesian national team. This research uses a qualitative approach with framing analysis from Zhongdang Pan and Gerald M.Kosicki. The results of this study indicate that the framing of news by Tempo.co media is more directed towards aspects that aim to straighten out the issue of dual citizenship in naturalized players of the Indonesian national team. The news presented only displays responses from official parties such as the Dutch Embassy, PSSI, and Immigration who have authority on the issue so that it only focuses on disclosing facts. Meanwhile, the Tribunnews.com media is more directed towards aspects that criticize the issue. The news presented emphasizes the criticism of various outside parties regarding the dual citizenship issue.
